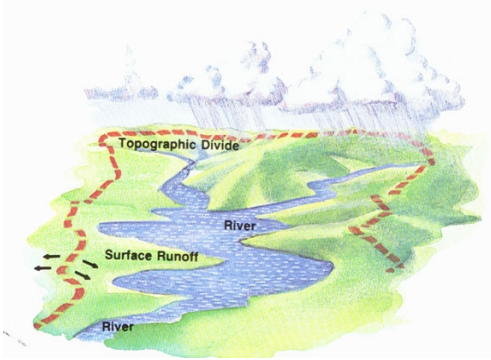
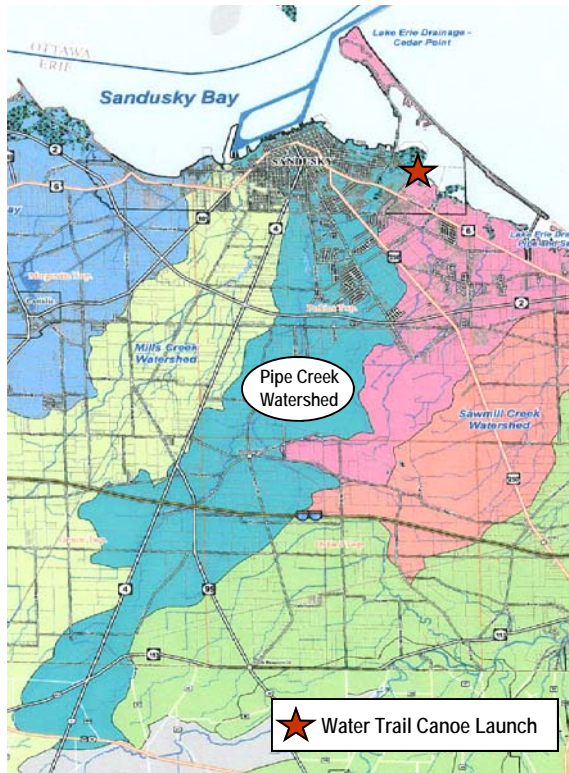


What is a watershed?

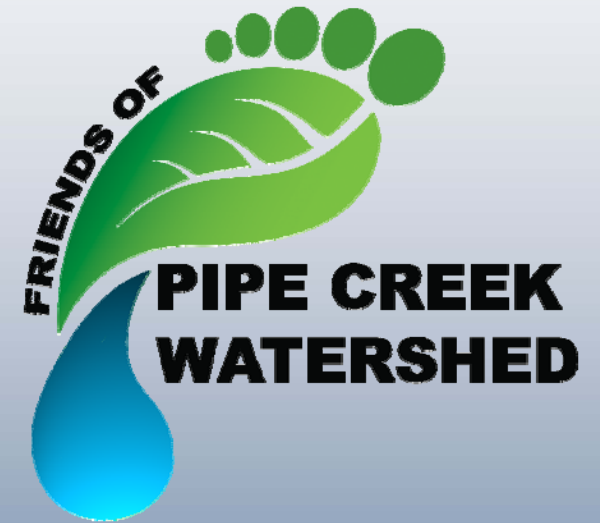


Pipe Creek Watershed
